

## Material Safety Statement

For FITC-Conjugated Purified IgG and FITC-Conjugated Affinity-Purified IgG

**Use of Product:** For *in vitro* research use only.

These products contain sodium azide ( $\leq 0.1\%$  w/v) in concentrations below the hazardous thresholds defined by the Hazardous Products Act (R.S., 1985, c. H-3) and the OSHA Hazard Communications Standard (CFR 1910.1200).

Though these products are not defined as hazardous, following standard laboratory practices for handling potentially dangerous reagents is advisable. Federal, provincial/state, or local waste disposal laws should be consulted prior to disposal of even small amounts of these products as sodium azide is considered a hazardous chemical at higher concentrations.
